

**ORDINANCE NO. 2399**

**AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING THE OPERATION OF THE BAKER MUNICIPAL BOXING COMMISSION, HEREAFTER KNOWN AS THE BOXING AND WRESTLING COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE OREGON REVISED STATUTES; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1810; AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF BY THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.**

Be it ordained by the City of Baker, Oregon:

Section 1. The Boxing Commission originally established by Ordinance No. 1810 of the City of Baker is hereby declared to continue in operation and shall hereafter be known as the Boxing and Wrestling Commission.

Section 2. Members of the Boxing and Wrestling Commission shall be appointed in accordance with ORS 463.110. The Boxing and Wrestling Commission shall have all the powers and duties as provided by state law.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 1810 of the City of Baker is hereby repealed.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and found that it is in the best interests and welfare of the people of the City of Baker that the Boxing Commission continue in conformance with state law and that it hereafter be known as the Boxing and Wrestling Commission. By virtue of the foregoing reason, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Baker, Oregon.
